The field tech may also assist in hosting public engagement events, educational workshops and outings, and site tours. The habitat techs will also assist the monitoring team in assessing habitat, collecting samples, deploying sampling devices, and more. The habitat technician will frequently work outdoors, while in and around running water.
